We will **not** be undertaking NHS COVID Pass checks for visits.



Face masks must be worn when entering the Cathedral.



Hand sanitiser will be placed upon entrance and Lichfield Cathedral would ask all visitors to use this.



All staff and volunteers have been asked to take regular lateral flow tests and we would ask that visitors consider taking a test ahead of attending the visiting. (results will not need to be disclosed, this is a suggestion only)
