

Mothering Sunday card instructions

You will need:

- Scissors
- Glue
- Green crayon
- Coloured pencils or pens (optional)



1. Print the following resources from the downloadable folder (each comes with a colour or black and white version, so you can choose whether to print in colour or to colour them in yourself):

- a. Card template
- b. Labels
- c. Bible verse
- d. Petals



2. Fold the card template in half, with the flower pot showing on the front.



3. Draw and colour in three green stems with leaves.



4. Cut out three petals and stick one at the top of each stem - these are the start of your tulips.



5. If you are printing in colour, cut out twelve petals and stick them back to back, so you end up with six petals with colour on both sides.
6. If you are printing in black and white, cut out six petals and colour them in on both sides.
7. Fold the six petals in half.



8. Stick two petals onto each tulip, overlapping the edges to create the whole flower.



9. Cut out a label saying 'Happy Mothering Sunday' and stick it to the front of your flower pot.



10. Cut out a Bible verse and stick it inside the card.



11. If you like, you can decorate the rest of the card.
